Visiting Our School Office

Our school office is open from 8:00 am - 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday, to assist you with anything you may need. However, we ask that you please call with any questions you may have, and only come to the building if absolutely necessary. Our phone number is 503-399-3201. Due to COVID restrictions and distancing protocols, visitors/parents may not enter the building. If you do need to visit our office, please ring the buzzer on the right hand side of the front door and we will assist you. We will be doing our best to maximize the instruction time. Families can help with this by **NOT** dropping off lunches, birthday treats, flowers or any other deliveries.

Students Arriving Late: Students arriving after 9:20 am (10:20 am on Wednesday) will need to enter through the front door and check in at the Main Office. Parents may call 503-399-3201 to let us know the student is coming, or send the student with a note. You do not need to come in to the building to check them in.

Students Leaving Early: If you need to pick up your student from school early please call the office (503-399-3201) prior to the pick-up time so that we can have your student ready to go. You will need to come to the front entrance and ring the buzzer to the right. Please bring your ID with you as we will be checking ID's before releasing students.

Parent Parking: During the hours of 10:00 am –3:00 pm (11-3 Wednesday) parents may park in the school parking lot if necessary. Please do not park in the Reserved parking spaces even if just for a few minutes.

IMPORTANT Arrival/Dismissal Procedures

Students should arrive between 8:55-9:15 am to ensure students are seated and ready to learn at 9:20 am. On Wednesday, our late start arrival will be 9:55-10:15 am with school starting at 10:20 am.

- The school parking lot will be limited to bus drop-off only. Students who are driven to school and dropped off will use the church parking lot across the street. A crossing guard will direct students crossing Jones Road. Students will then walk to their designated entrance.
- 1. To avoid congestion at the Jones Road entrance, please use the entrance on Lone Oak Road and exit out onto Jones Road, or back out onto Lone Oak Road.
- 2. We ask that you not park in the parking spaces close to Jones Road. It causes congestion as parents try to back out when others are pulling in
- 3. Bikes may be ridden and locked in the bike rack on the south side of the building. Students will need to provide their own lock.
- 4. Any student who arrives after 9:20 am (10:20 am on Wednesday) will need to enter through the front door and check in at the Main Office.

Dismissal will be at 4:00 pm.

- The school parking lot will be limited to bus drop-off only. Students being picked up from school will walk across Jones Road and meet their ride in the church parking lot across the street. A crossing guard will direct students across Jones Road.
- 1. To avoid congestion at the Jones Road entrance, please use the entrance on Lone Oak Road and exit out onto Jones Road or back out onto Lone Oak Road.
- 2. We also ask that you not park in the parking spaces close to Jones Road. It causes congestion as parents try to back out when others are pulling in.
- It is important that students are picked up no later than 4:15 pm.

All 7th & 8th grade students need to have a copy of a current physical on file **BEFORE** they can begin practice. Physicals are valid for two years. Physicals need to be recorded on the OSAA School Sports Pre-Participation Examination forms and downloaded to the FamilyID website. Physical forms are available on the Judson website <https://salkeiz.k12.or.us/wp-content/uploads/2017/05/Physical-Examination.pdf>, or on the FamilyID website.

Mask Protocol for Sports:

Indoor or Outdoor

Students are not required to wear a mask indoors or outdoors when practicing or playing a competitive sport at any level, including cheerleading and dance/drill. Students not actively participating (i.e., on the sideline during an indoor or outdoor competition, etc.) are required to wear a mask. Students are required to wear a mask when in the weight room.

Indoor

Coaches and support staff, regardless of vaccination status, are required to wear a mask during indoor practices and competitions. This includes weight training regardless of location.

Spectators (5 years or older) are required to wear a mask, regardless of vaccination status, at indoor practices and competitions.

Students are not required to wear a mask indoors when playing an instrument that requires the mouth. Choir and speech students are required to wear a mask during indoor practices but are exempt from this requirement for performances.

Outdoor

Coaches and support staff, regardless of vaccination status, are required to wear a mask during outdoor practices and competitions when 6' of physical distance cannot be maintained.

Spectators (5 years or older) are required to wear a mask, regardless of vaccination status, at outdoor practices and competitions when 6' of physical distance cannot be maintained.

Lockers

Students should bring a backpack with them to school each day to carry their Chromebook and school supplies with them throughout the day. Lockers will not be used for the 2021-2022 school year. This will make passing time a smoother transition for students.

Chromebooks

If you still have a Chromebook from last year please return it ASAP so that your students can receive a new Chromebook this year. Chromebooks will be distributed to students on Thursday, September 9th and Friday, September 10th during school. Please make sure your students bring their charged Chromebooks to school everyday.
